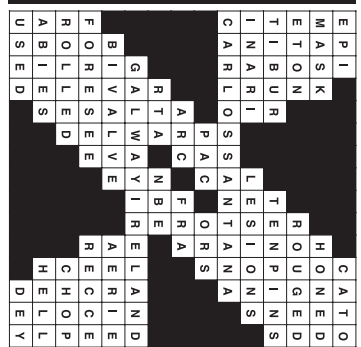

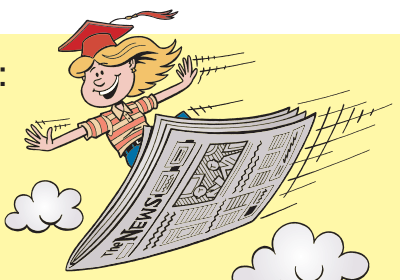

- two or more lines put together that usually follow the same meter and rhyme
- words that **SOUND** like their meanings: **buzz, hiss, crack, crunch**
- string of words that all have the Same Starting Sound
- a little bounce within a poem that sets a funky beat
- organization of each line of poetry, takes into account the number of syllables and which syllable is stressed
- when two or more words have similar ending sounds, as in **ground and round and pound**
