On September 30, 2010, GreenLight Gas ("GreenLight"), in accordance with the Gas Utility Regulatory Act, filed an application with the Texas Railroad Commission to change GreenLight's city gate gas transportation rate for gas utility service to the following cities and nearby unincorporated areas: REVISED
NOTICE OF RATE CHANGE
On September 30, 2010, GreenLight Gas ("GreenLight"), in accordance with the Gas Utility Regulatory Act, filed an application with the Texas Railroad Commission to change GreenLight's city gate gas transportation rate for gas utility service to the following cities and nearby unincorporated areas: Clarendon, Dodson, Dozier, Estelline, Hedley, Lakeview, Lelia Lake, Lufkin, Memphis, Newlin, Paducah, Samnorwood and Wellington. A revision to the application was filed with the Railroad Commission. The proposed rate is \$2.628 per mcf. GreenLight proposes to recover rate case expenses through a \$0.046 per mcf surcharge which will be in effect for three years. The combination of the rate plus the surcharge results in a rate of \$2.674 which reflects an increase of \$0.254 per mcf and is expected to increase GreenLight's revenue by about 2.7%. About 3,255 residential and 523 commercial customers would be affected. An average residential monthly bill (4.5 mcf) would see an increase of \$1.14 per month. An average commercial monthly bill (31.3 mcf) would see an increase of \$7.95 per month. This rate change requested by GreenLight, which is organized as a not-for-profit company constitutes a major increase as defined by Section 104.101 of the Texas Utilities Code. The effective date of this proposed rate change is December 1, 2010.
