2631.00 (This occurred 5-27-2011). 1. Goal:  
achieve 30 percent reduction in total water  
use, and daily water demand. 2. Supply Man-  
agement Measures: The water authority would  
lower the level in all storage tanks, thus reduc-  
ing pressure on wholesale customers system.  
This in turn would help conserve an even  
greater amount of water. 3. The General Manager, or his designee, will  
contact wholesale water customers to discuss
