Changes in county election precincts were designed to achieve numerical balance between the four commissioners court precincts, and to insure the voting rights of all citizens of Donley County, Texas.

**LEGAL NOTICE:** The Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District (District), in compliance with Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code, will receive public comment on the proposed amendments to the Rules of the District at a public hearing at District Office, located at 201 West Third Street, White Deer, Texas, on Wednesday, April 4, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. The District Board at the conclusion of the public hearing will discuss comments received and consider possible adoption of the proposed rules. Written and oral public comments on the proposed rules must be submitted to the District on or prior to the hearing date. The following is a brief outline of the substantive rule changes:

1. Rule 4 - The District proposes to require wells classified as exempt use under the oil and gas exploration statute to meet spacing rules.

2. Rule 6.4 - The District proposes to add a rule to require oil and gas operators that have required a registration to install meters and report production annually.  
 3. Rule 10.2 - The District added Groundwater Management Area (GMA) hearings to the hearing procedures.  
 4. Rule 12 - The District added language required by new legislation to clarify the role of the District's Management Plan and GMA planning.  
 5. Rule 15.1 - The District added language to clarify the 50/50 Management Standard has been adopted as the desired future condition (DFC) for the Ogallala Aquifer.  
 6. Rule 15.4 - The District added required DFC language for the minor aquifers in the District, the Dockum and Blaine Aquifers. The DFC for the Dockum Aquifer is to decline no more than 30 feet in 50 years, and the DFC for the Blaine Aquifer is to have at least 50% of water supplies remaining in 50 years.
