RESOLUTION CALLING A BOND ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT AND THE GIVING NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; AND ENACTING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT WHEREAS, this City Council has determined that it is advisable to call and hold an election within the City of Clarendon, Texas, on the proposition hereinafter set forth; Now, Therefore BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARENDON:

Section 1. Election Order; Proposition.
 An election shall be held in the City of Clarendon, Texas, on May 12, 2012, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., at which election the following proposition shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION
 Shall the City Council of the City of Clarendon, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$700,000, with the bonds of each such series or issue, respectively, to mature as to principal, not to exceed 40 years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, for the purpose of constructing, improving, extending, expanding, upgrading and developing streets and roads, as follows: 6th Street (Koogle Street to Goodnight Street), 3rd Street (Allen Street to Bugbee Street), Allen Street (3rd Street to Fifth Street), Sims Street (3rd Street to 4th Street), Carhart Street (6th Street to Highway 287), Clarendon Avenue (Bugbee Street to the west end), Regent Avenue (Clarendon Street to Highway 287) and Wood Street (Jackson Street to Faker Street), with any remaining bond proceeds to be used for other streets and roads as the City Council may determine, including bridges and intersections including utility relocation, landscaping, sidewalks, traffic safety and operational improvements, the purchase of any necessary right-of-way, drainage and other related costs, and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

Section 2. Precincts and Polling Places.
 The election precincts for said election only, and the polling place for each such precinct on election day, are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, which is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof for all purposes.
 Section 3. Early Voting.
 The Early Voting Polling Place, the Branch Early Voting Polling Places for conducting early voting by personal appearance, the dates and hours for early voting by personal appearance and the address for early voting by mail for said election are hereby designated as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.
 Section 4. Election Officers.
 The election officers designated by the Donley County elections office are hereby appointed and confirmed to hold said election at said polling places. As determined by the Donley County elections office, the Presiding Judges shall appoint not less than two nor more than five qualified election clerks to serve and assist in conducting said election; providing that if the Presiding Judge actually serves as expected, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall serve as such clerks. An early ballot book is hereby created to process early voting results, and the individual designated by the Donley County elections office is hereby appointed the presiding judge of said board. The presiding judge shall appoint at least two other members of the board. Fay Vargas, Donley County Clerk, shall serve as early voting clerk for the election.

Section 5. Ballots.
 The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote

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"FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION to be expressed substantially as follows:
