# **INVITATION & OPERATION**

Since 1924, the Clarendon Chamber of Commerce has worked to promote the development of commercial, agricultural, and tourism opportunities Clarendon and Donley County. The Chamber is governed by a nine-member board from which is elected a president and vice president. A Manager, hired by the board, oversees the daily operations of the Chamber.

The Chamber is a member-driven organization of businesses, organizations, and individuals who are working together to improve the economic, civic, and cultural well-being of our community. Any individual, association or organization, estate, company, firm, partnership, or corporation who is in harmony with the purpose of the Chamber is eligible and invited to apply for membership.

# MEMBER BENEFITS

THE CLARENDON VISITOR CENTER: The Chamber of Commerce, in cooperation with the Clarendon Economic Development Corp. (CEDC), helps operate the city's official visitor center located in downtown Clarendon inside the historic Mulkey Theatre. The Visitor Center is open daily, Monday-Friday, and serves to welcome visitors to our community as well to provide information about Clarendon and Donley County to those passing through. Chamber and CEDC personnel also respond to requests for information over the telephone, through email, and via social media. The Visitor Center also distributes local maps, phone books, and city brochures.

RIBBON CUTTINGS: Chamber members may request

an official Ribbon Cutting to celebrate opening a new business or new location, remodeling their facilities, or a change of ownership.



BROCHURE & BUSINESS CARD DISPLAY: Chamber members are permitted and encouraged to display their business cards and brochures at the Visitor Center for easy access by newcomers to our city. Restaurants that join the Chamber are also encouraged to leave "togo" copies of their menus for our out-of-town guests.

**E-MAIL NEWSLETTER & UPDATES**: The Chamber Chatter is a monthly e-newsletter distributed to members with information on coming events, Chamber activities, and business news. The Chamber also distributes by e-mail a monthly calendar of events and other important information as the need arises.

ONLINE BUSINESS DIRECTORY: The Chamber website – www.ClarendonChamber.com – features a listing of Chamber members organized by business category with links to members' websites.
