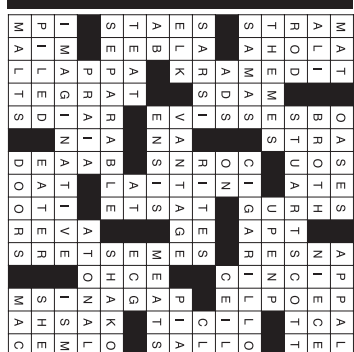

LEGAL NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 467
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLAREN-
DON, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE # 423
REGULATING THE DRILLING OF A WATER WELL
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY
OF CLARENDON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CLARENDON,
TEXAS:

That Section 3.02.038(a)2 of the Code of Ord-
nances, City of Clarendon, Texas, are hereby
amended to read as follows;
Section 1.

"Sec. 3.02.038. Regulating the drilling of a
water well.

"(a) No water well may be drilled within the cor-
porate limits of the City of Clarendon, Texas,
without complying with the following regula-
tions:

(1) An application must be filed with the City's
Code Enforcement office to which is attached
a plat showing the following: legal description
and street address of the property upon which
the well is to be drilled; boundary lines of the
property upon which the well is to be located;
location of the well; and depth the well is to be
drilled. A copy of the City permit will be sent
to the Panhandle Groundwater Conservation
District ("District") whose principal office is
located in White Deer, Texas. Any water well
must comply with all of the rules and regula-
tions of the District.

(2) No well may be located nearer than sev-
enty-five feet (75') from the sewer lines which
provide such service by the City.

(3) The well shall not be connected with any
water distribution lines which provide such city
utility services to the property

(4) The well will be completed so that none of
the water produced will contaminate the water
main of the City or any of the service lines on
said property.

"(b) No sales of the water from the wells are
permitted nor may such water be provided
without charge for any off-premises use.

"(c) A non-refundable administrative fee of
Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid when the
application is filed.

"(d) If the application complies with these
regulations, the code enforcement office shall
issue a permit.

"(e) City personnel shall have the right of
ingress and egress to the property upon which
the well is located during normal business
hours to inspect the well to insure compliance
with these regulations."

This ordinance shall be effective upon its final
passage and shall be enforced ten (10) days
after final publication was provided by law.
PASSED AND APPROVED on the 23 day
of March, 2017.
