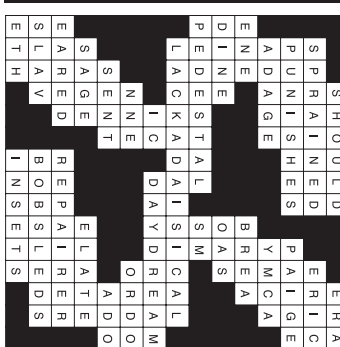

The Clarendon College District conducted public
hearings on August 10, 2017, and August 17, 2017,
on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of
the Clarendon College District from properties on
the tax roll in the preceding year by 7.99 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last
year at last year's tax rate of \$.230677 for each \$100
of taxable value was \$517,875.
