BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEDLEY, TEXAS:


Section 1: That it is unlawful for any person. corporation, company, or other entity that does not pay the City for Refuse Service and whose residence is situated outside the City limits, to dump garbage or any waste material within the City limits of the City of Hedley. Authorized persons, for the purpose of the ordinance, are those who pay a monthly fee for use of City Sanitation Services.


Section 2: That any person, corporation, company or other entity violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined a sum not to exceed \$2,000.00 to \$4,000.00. Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) petitioned the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on August 28, 2017 for authority to reconcile its eligible fuel expenses and revenues for the period from March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2017 (Reconciliation Period). This application, if granted, will affect all Texas retail customers.

During the Reconciliation Period, SWEPCO incurred a total of \$670,859,057 in eligible fuel, fuel-related expenses, and purchased-power costs to generate and purchase electric energy for its Texas retail customers, as well as expenses associated with environmental consumables and emission allowance costs allocated to its Texas retail customers. As of the end of the Reconciliation Period, SWEPCO calculates that it has over-recovered its Texas retail fuel, fuel related, and purchased-power costs by \$4,384,730, excluding interest. Including interest, SWEPCO's cumulative over-recovery balance is \$4,459,126 as of February 28, 2017.

NOTICE OF ELECTIONS TEXAS PEANUT PRODUCERS BOARD **VOTING REGION TWO**

The Texas Peanut Producers Board (TPPB) will conduct a 2018 biennial election. The TPPB elections will be conducted in 145 Texas counties for the purpose of electing four TPPB board members: one member from Voting Region One, two members from Voting Region Two and one member from Voting Region 4. There are a total of nine TPPB voting board members.

There are two seats open for election in Voting Region Two, which consists of Archer, Armstrong, Baylor, Borden, Briscoe, Carson, Childress, Collingsworth, Cottle, Crosby, Dickens, Donley, Fisher, Floyd, Foard, Garza, Gray, Hall, Hansford, Hardeman, Haskell, Hemphill, Hutchinson, Jones, Kent, King, Knox, Lipscomb, Motley, Ochiltree, Roberts, Scurry, Shackelford, Stephens, Stonewall, Throckmorton, Wheeler, Wichita, Wilbarger and Young counties.

According to the Texas Commodity Referendum Law, Texas Agriculture Code, Title 3, Ch. 41, Subchapter C, Section 41, peanut producers eligible to vote are persons, including the owner of a farm on which peanuts are produced or the owner's tenant or sharecropper, engaged in the business of producing peanuts or causing peanuts to be produced for commercial purposes. For a producer to vote for a Voting Region 2 seat, the voter must reside within one of the counties stated above.

Any eligible voter in Region 2 may submit a petition to be placed on the ballot to serve as a TPPB Region 2 director. Nomination applications must be submitted to TPPB, signed by the applicant and ten additional eligible voters from the region.

Nomination forms will be available in the counties listed above or can be obtained by writing TPPB, 5223 79th St, Lubbock, TX 79424. Please state your county of residence if you request a nomination form in writing. Nomination forms will be available Nov. 23, 2017 and must be filed no later than Dec. 23, 2017.

The election will be held by mail ballot. Ballots containing the nominations of all persons who have validly filed petitions will be available to eligible voters beginning Jan. 9, 2018 at peanut buying points and county agent offices, or by writing TPPB at the address stated above. Voters may also vote for board members by "writing in" the name of any eligible persons. Ballots must be postmarked no later than Jan. 23, 2018 to be counted.

TPPB is certified under Section 41.011 and Section 41.021 of the Texas Commodity Referendum Law to conduct this referendum and has obtained all approvals and determinations required by law from the Commissioner of Agriculture, Texas Department of Agriculture.
