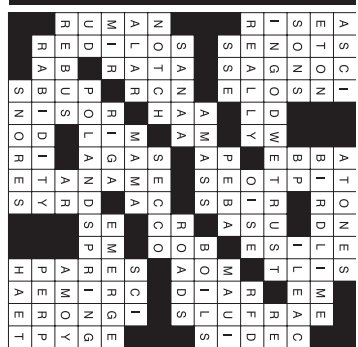

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO RECONCILE FUEL COSTS

Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) petitioned the Public
Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on August 28, 2017 for authority to
reconcile its eligible fuel expenses and revenues for the period from March 1, 2014
through February 28, 2017 (Reconciliation Period). This application, if granted,
will affect all Texas retail customers.

During the Reconciliation Period, SWEPCO incurred a total of
\$670,859,057 in eligible fuel, fuel-related expenses, and purchased-power costs
to generate and purchase electric energy for its Texas retail customers, as well as
expenses associated with environmental consumables and emission allowance
costs allocated to its Texas retail customers. As of the end of the Reconciliation
Period, SWEPCO calculates that it has over-recovered its Texas retail fuel, fuel
related, and purchased-power costs by \$4,384,730, excluding interest. Including
interest, SWEPCO's cumulative over-recovery balance is \$4,459,126 as of Febru-
ary 28, 2017.
