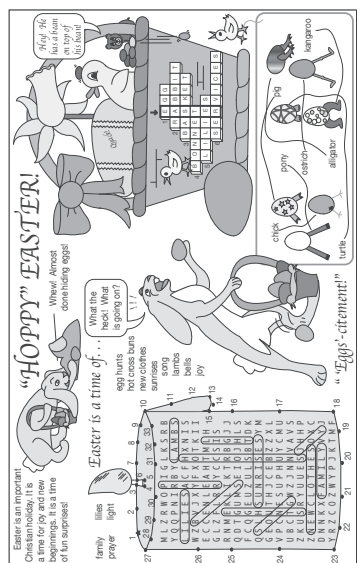
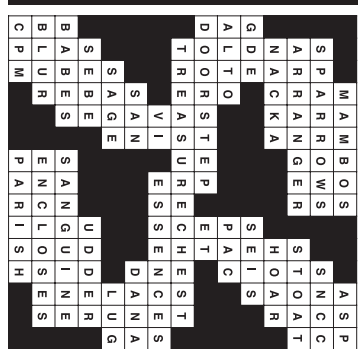

On or about April 9th, 2018 the City of Hedley
will submit a request to the Texas Department
of Agriculture for the release of funds under
Community Development Block Grant funds
under Section 104(f) of Title I of the Housing
and Community Development Act of 1974 as
amended, to undertake the following project:

Project Title: The City of Hedley, Water and
Sewer System Improvement Project #7217190
Purpose: The City shall make improvements
to the standpipe in order to prevent frequent
maintenance issues and disruptions in ser-
vice. The City will rehabilitate the standpipe,
install safety and access equipment, interior
coating, and all associated appurtenances.
The City will also rehabilitate the lift station
to prevent frequent maintenance issues and
provide adequate sewer service. The City
will install approximately thirty linear feet (30
l.f.) of sewer line, two (2) pumps, electrical
improvements, and all associated appurten-
ances.

Location: Construction on the standpipe shall
take place on Short Street, between Railroad
Street and N. 1st Street. Construction on the
lift station shall take place along S. 6th Street,
between Main Street and Highway 287.
Estimated Cost: \$275,000.00 (Grant funds)
and \$17,500.00 (City matching funds pro-
vided by the City of Hedley) for a total project
cost of \$292,500.00.

The activities proposed are categorically
excluded under HUD regulations at 24 CFR
Part 58 from National Environmental Policy
Act (NEPA) requirements. An Environmental
Review Record (ERR) that documents the
environmental determinations for this project
is on file at The City of Hedley, 109 Main
St, Hedley Texas 79237 or at the Panhandle
Regional Planning Commission at 415 W. 8th
Avenue, Amarillo, Texas and may be examined
or copied weekdays 8 A.M. to 5 P.M.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The City of Hedley certifies to the Texas Depart-
ment of Agriculture that Carrie Butler in her
capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdic-
tion of the Federal Courts if an action is
brought to enforce responsibilities in relation
to the environmental review process and that
these responsibilities have been satisfied. The

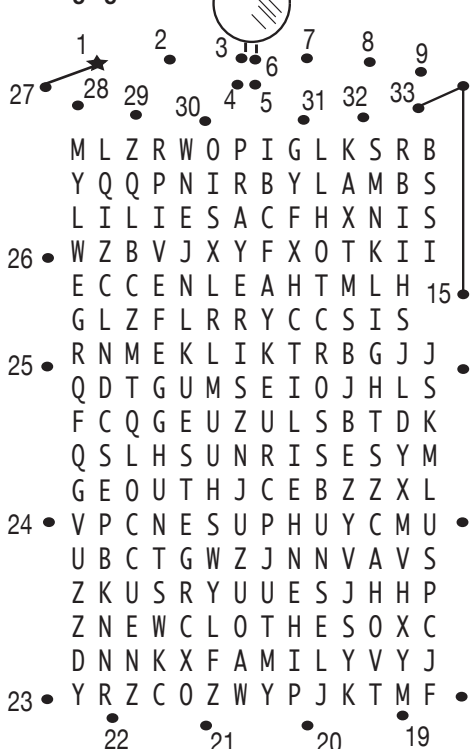

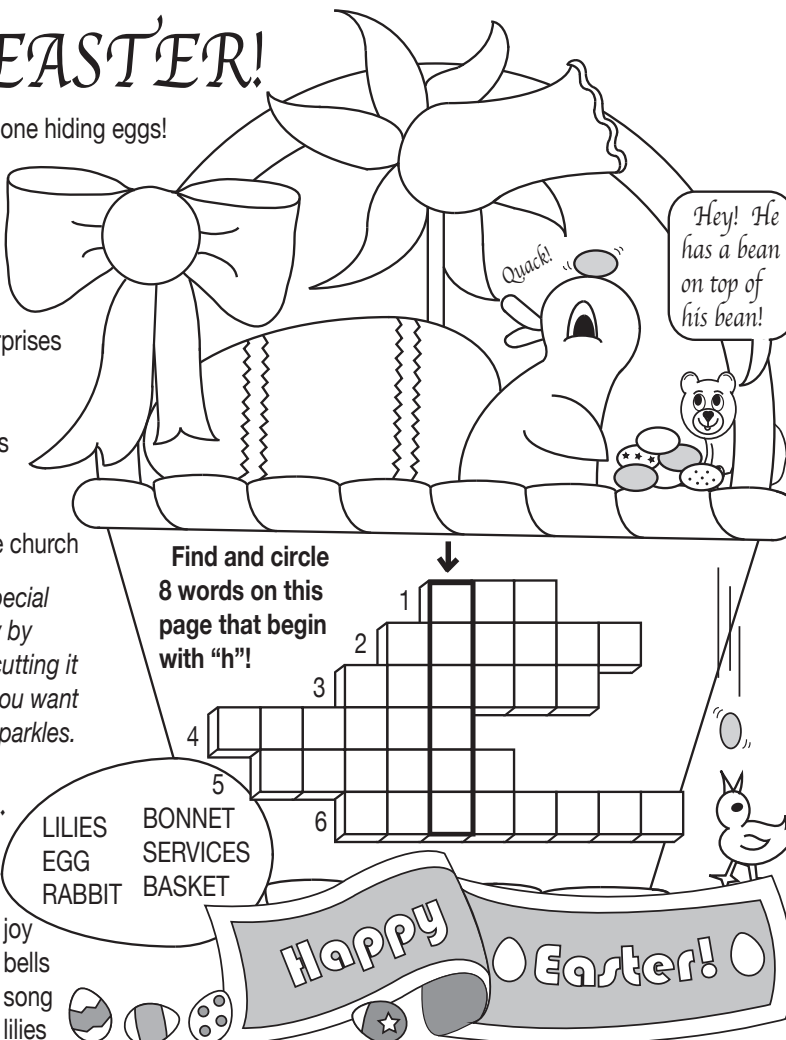
