What's Blowing in the Wind?



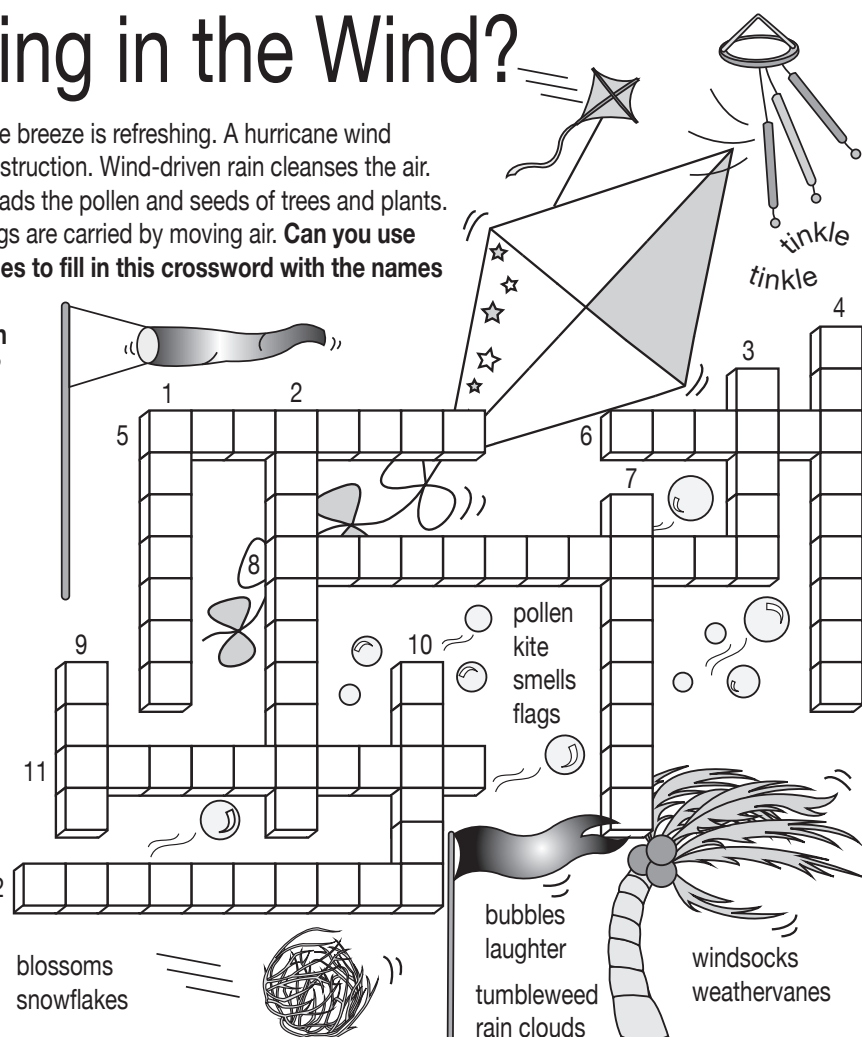
Windy Workout!
