mark time.

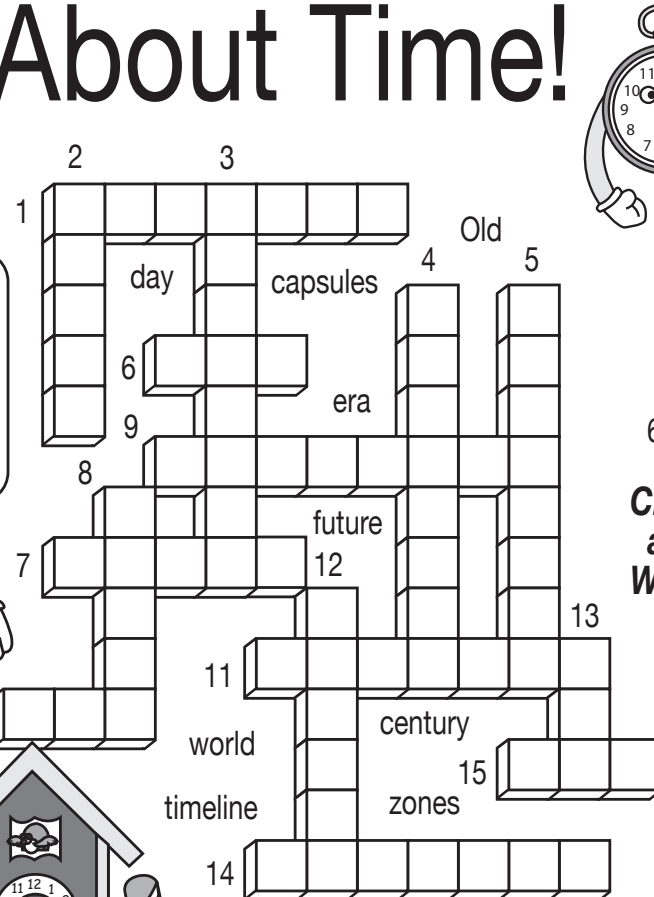
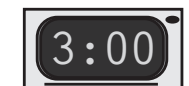
