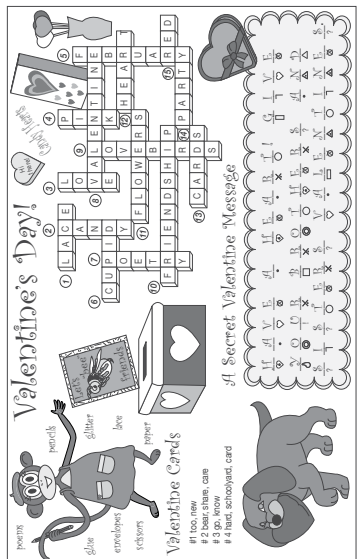
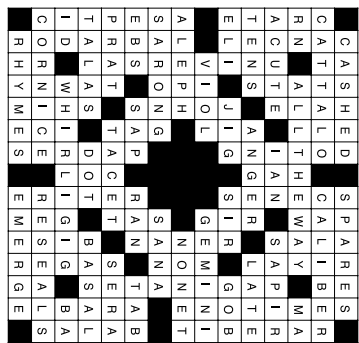

ADOPTION OF THE DONLEY COUNTY MULTI- JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

The City of Howardwick City Council will
conduct a public hearing before considering
final adoption of the recently completed
2019 Donley County Hazard Mitigation Plan
Update on February 12, 2019 at 6 p.m. in the
Council Chambers of the City of Howardwick
City Hall located at 245 Rick Husband Blvd.
Howardwick, Texas. This plan incorporates
mitigation actions intended to minimize the
impacts of certain natural hazards on the
residents of the City.

The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as
amended, requires that local governments,
develop, adopt, and update natural hazard
mitigation plans in order to receive certain
federal assistance. A Mitigation Action Team
("MAT") comprised of representatives from
Donley County, the City of Clarendon, City
of Hedley, City of Howardwick, Hedley ISD,
Howardwick ISD, was convened to assess
the risks from and vulnerabilities to natural
hazards that are endemic to the Donley
County area, and to make recommendations
on mitigating the effects of such hazards. The
original Hazard Mitigation plan was adopted
in 2006 and in order to maintain its approved
status by the Federal Emergency Management
Agency (FEMA), it has to be updated every five
(5) years.

A copy of the Donley County plan update
is now available for review in the Donley
County Judge's office, each City Hall, ISD
Superintendent Office or it may be reviewed

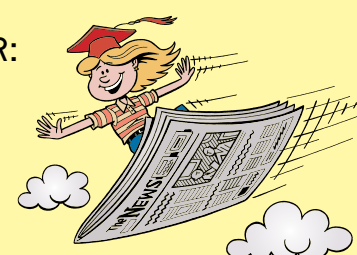

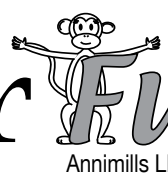

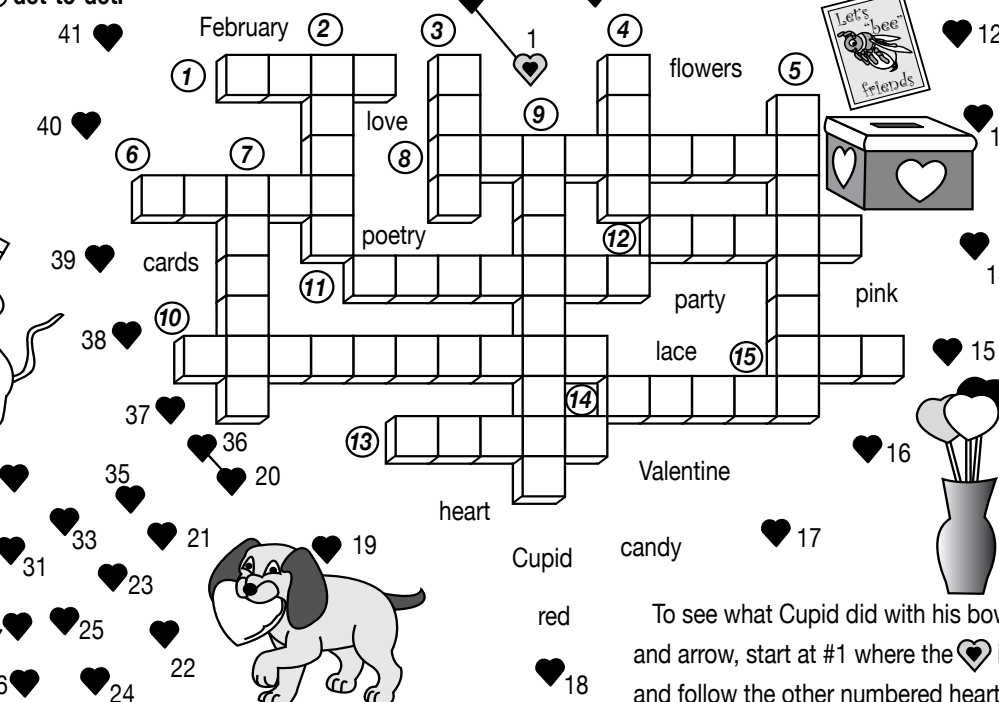
