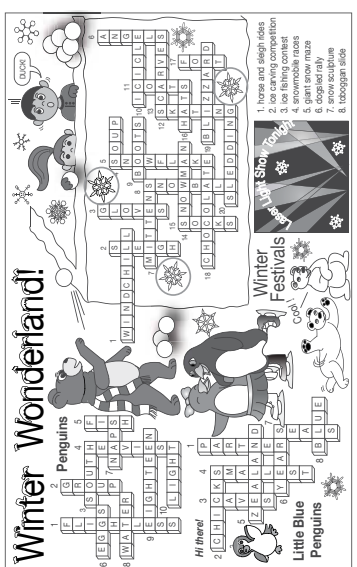
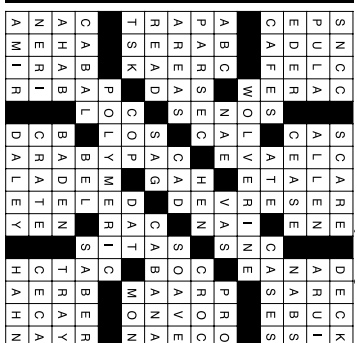

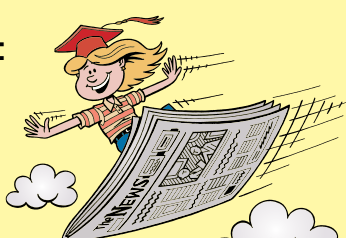

and cheese, chicken pot pies and, for dessert, bread pudding!

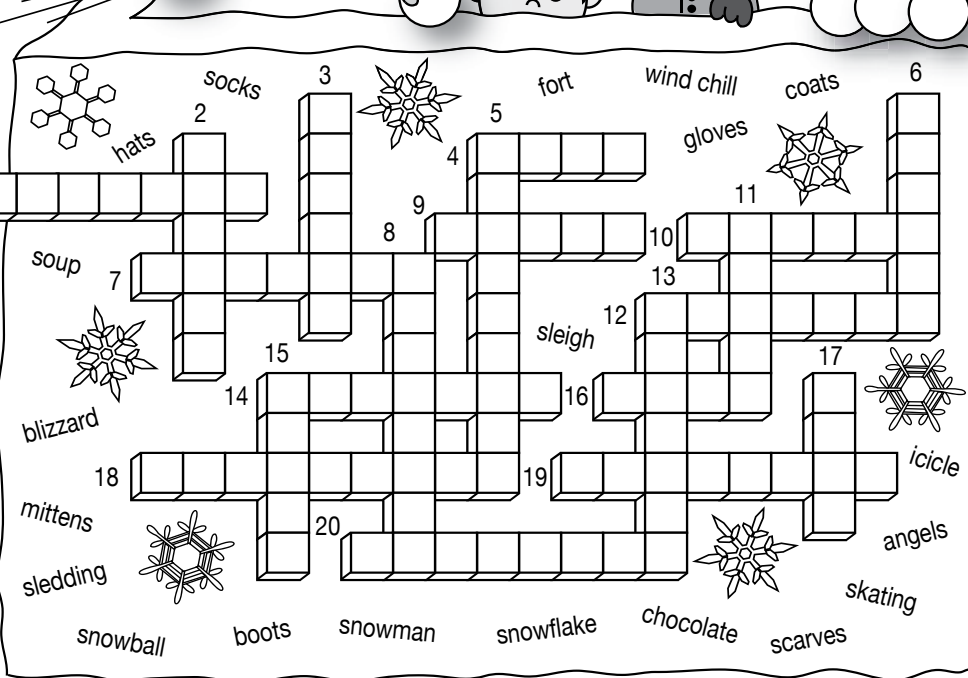
