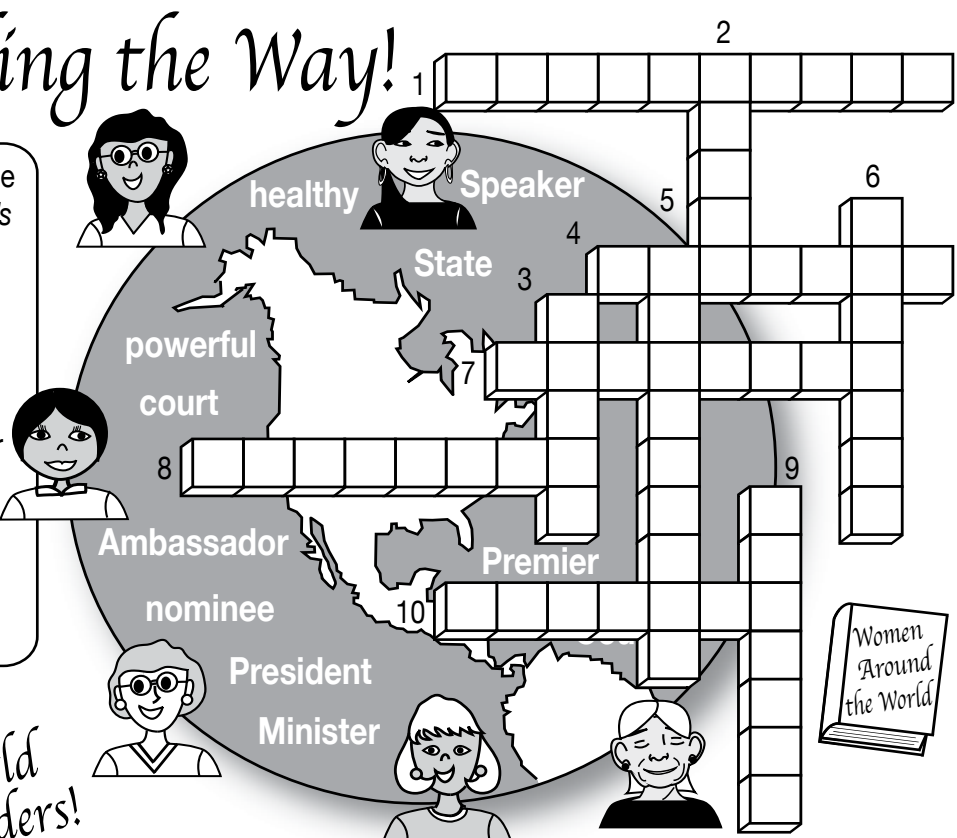
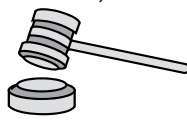
Women Leading the Way!
