In early spring, you'll notice many changes.

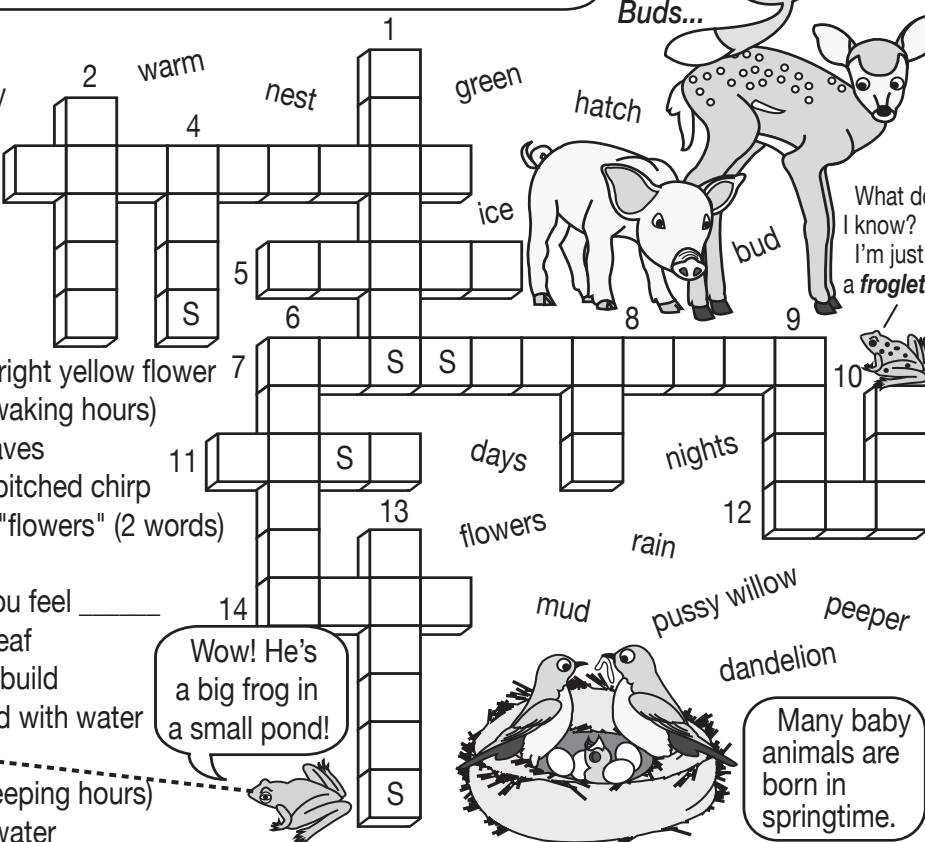
