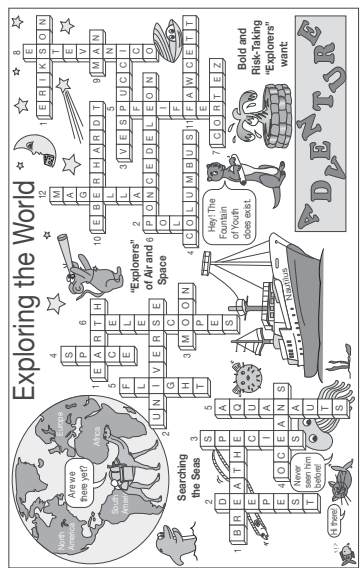

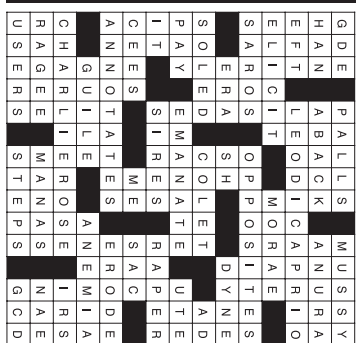

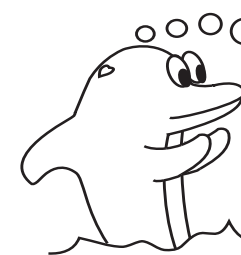

- Leif _____ - an explorer from Iceland who landed in North America about 500 years before Columbus.
- Marco _____ - Venetian explorer; traveled into China and other parts of Asia. He was the first European to meet Kublai Khan, the emperor of China.
- Amerigo _____ - Italian explorer, thought to have sailed past Brazil. The Americas were named after him.
- Christopher _____ - born in Genoa, (which is now part of Italy), but was sponsored by Spain's King and Queen, who gave him three famous ships: Niña, Pinta and Santa Maria. He made 4 trips to the "New World."
- Ida Laura _____ - Austrian explorer; traveled around the world more than once. Her books about her travels were published in seven languages.
- Juan _____ - first European explorer to land in Florida (which he named). Legend says that he wanted to find "The Fountain of Youth."
- Hernando _____ - Spanish Explorer who led an expedition to South America, which in turn led to the downfall of the Aztec Empire.
- _____ - thought to be the first African-born man to step in North America. He was a slave to an explorer and he scouted much of the Southwest.

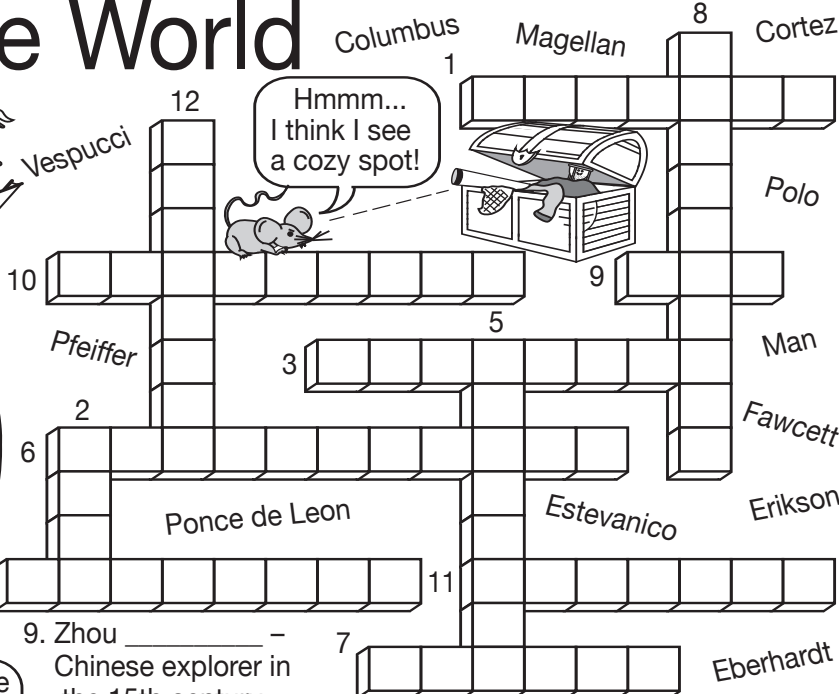
