Chinese New Year Celebration

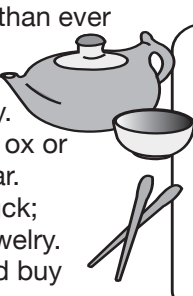
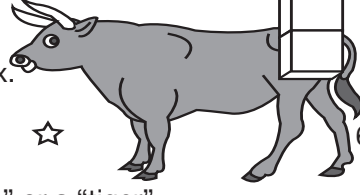
The Chinese New Year celebration begins with
