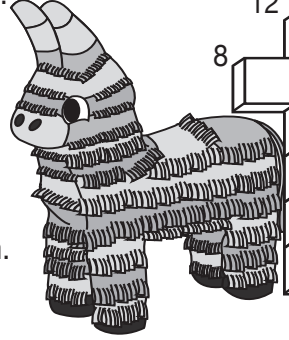
Day of the Child El Día de los Niños
