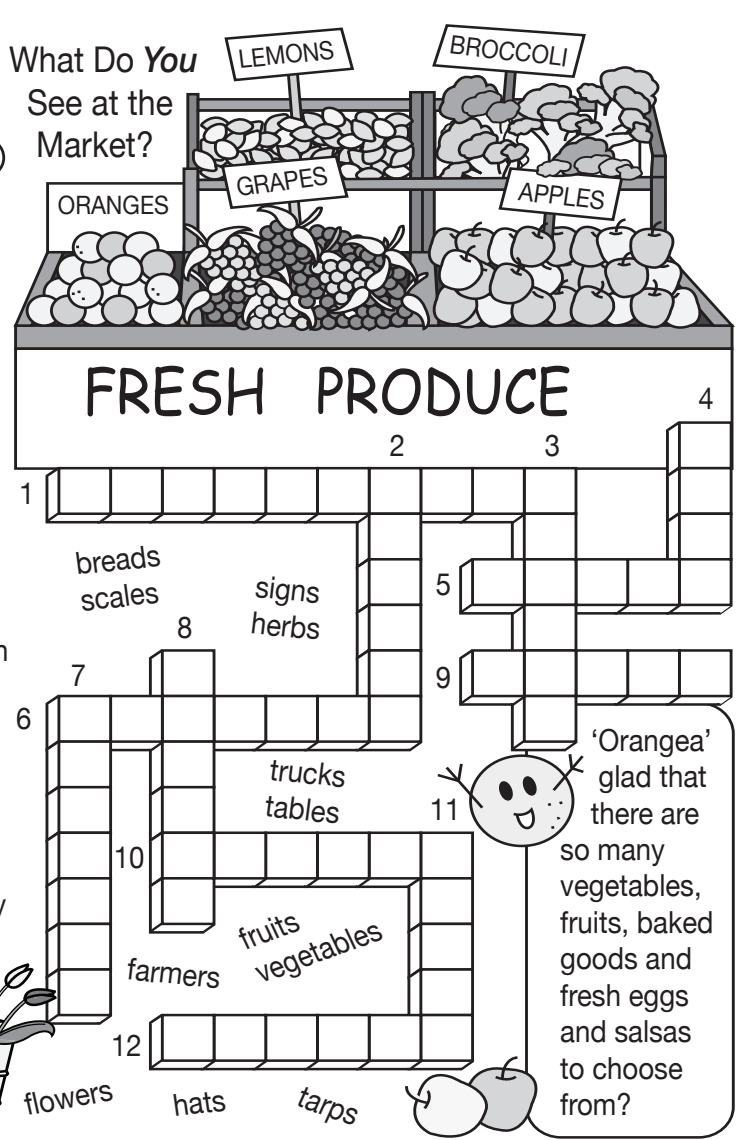


You can't buy fresher fruits and vegetables than
