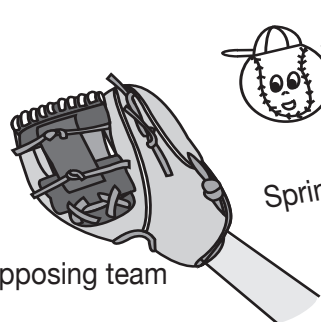
## Baseball Fun for Everyone!

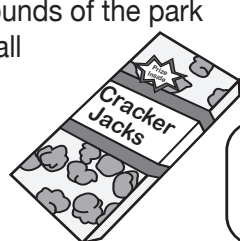

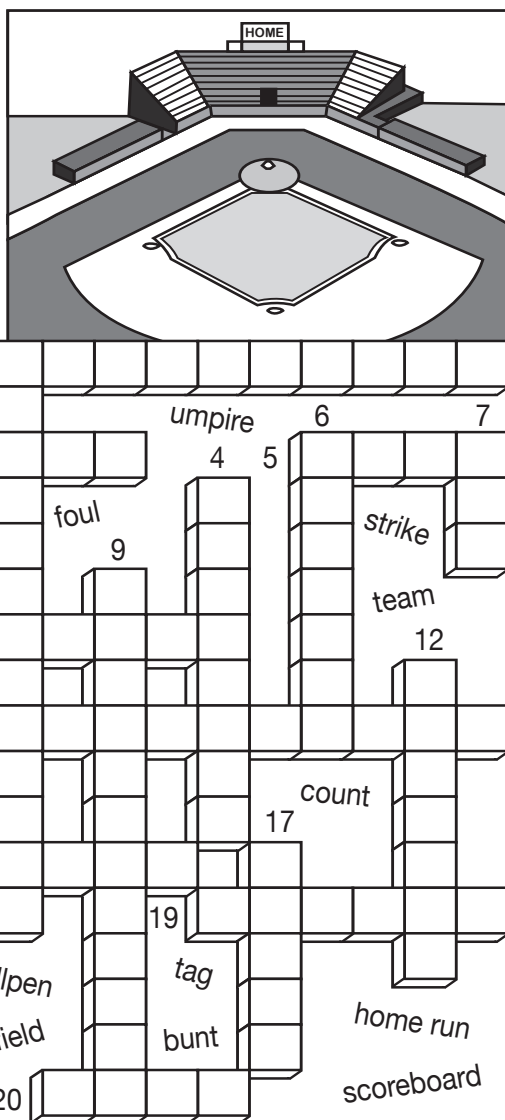
