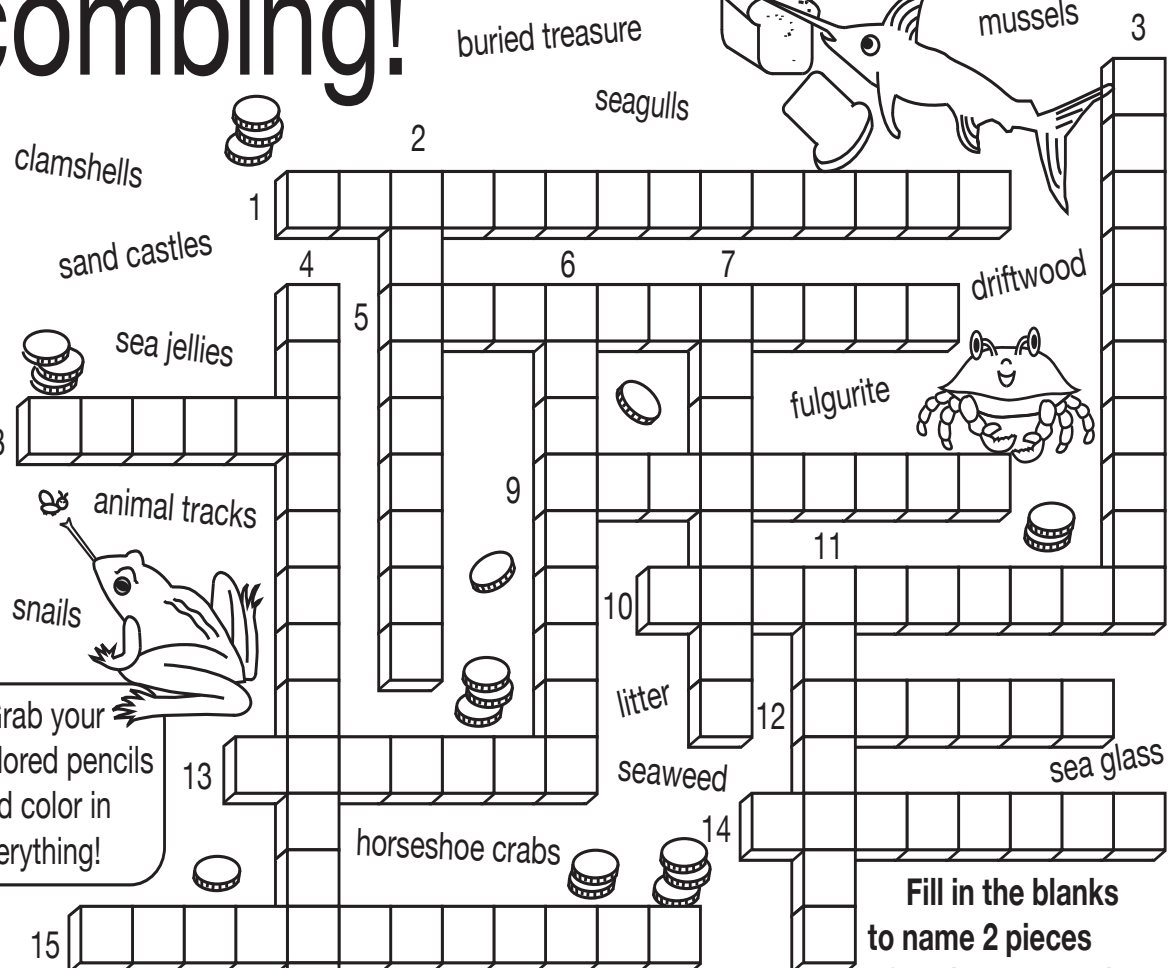
What kinds
