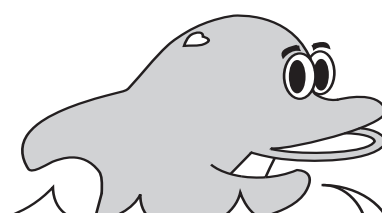


**Life on the Ship!**
