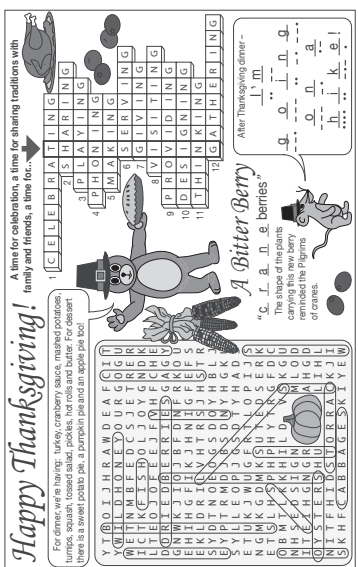

to repair the subsequent damage to finishes,
such as interior plaster repair and replace-
ment, wood trim repair and refinishing, wood

exterior masonry cleaning.

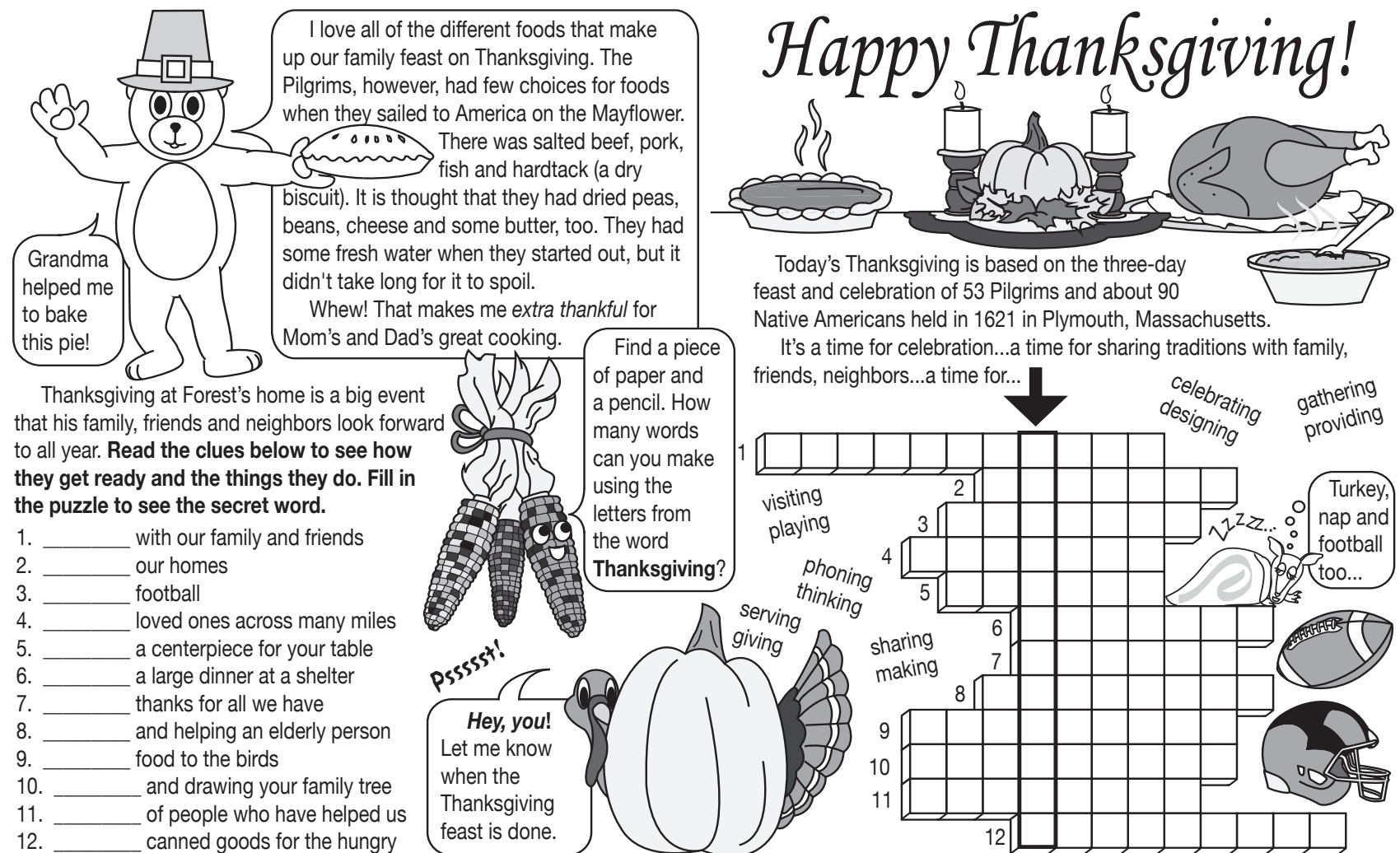
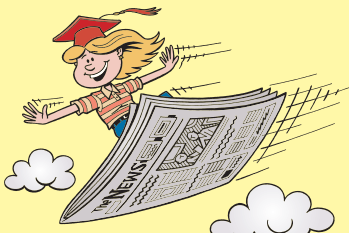
