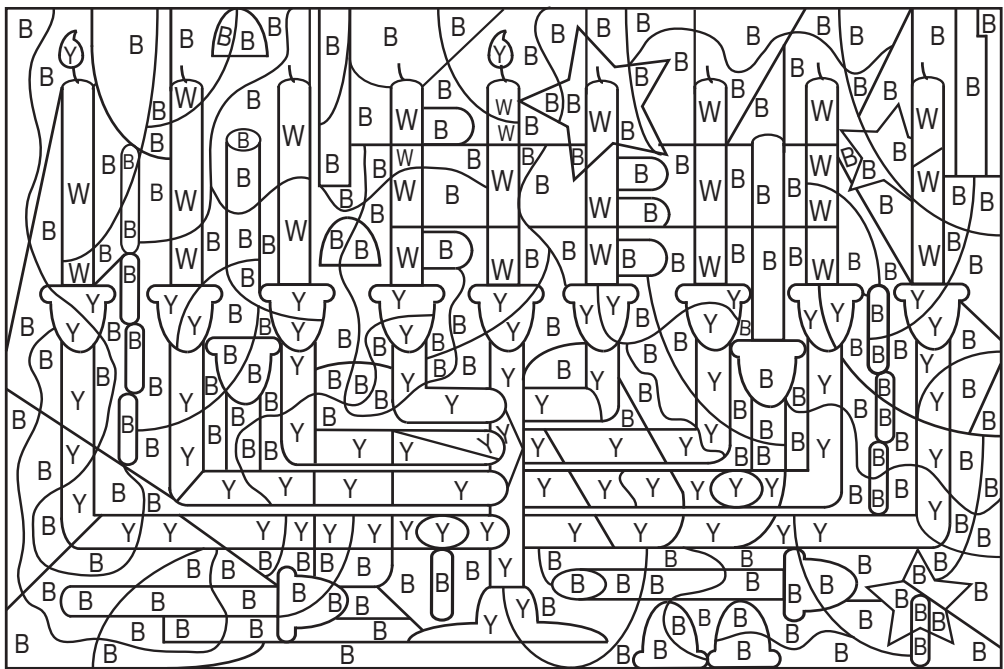

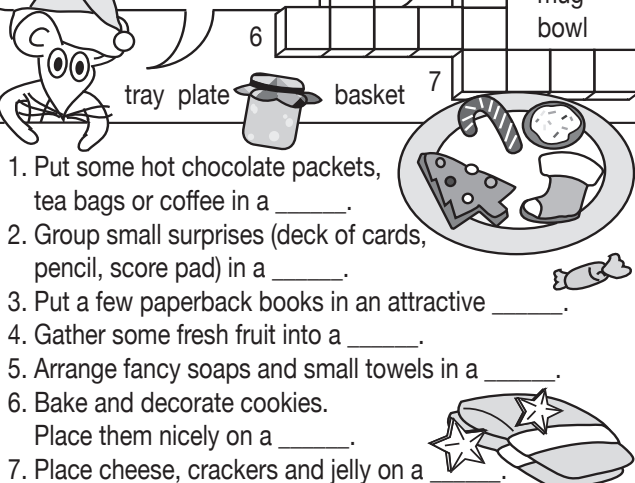
Color Key: Y = yellow B = blue W = white
