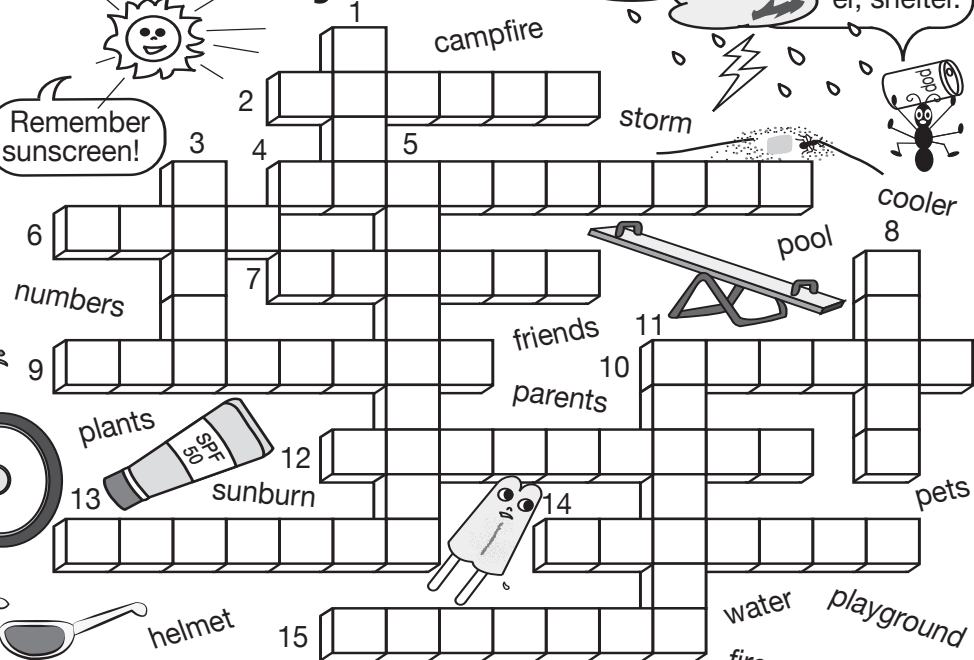


## When School's Out, Safety's In!

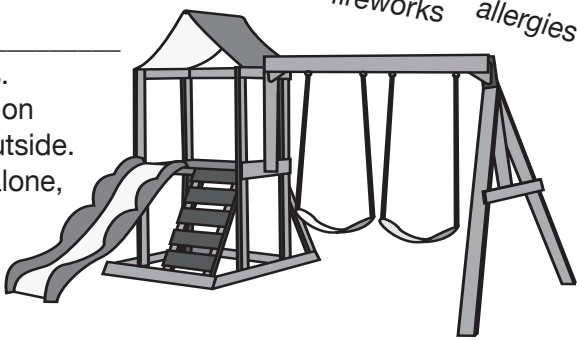
When school is out, you will have to *take care*
