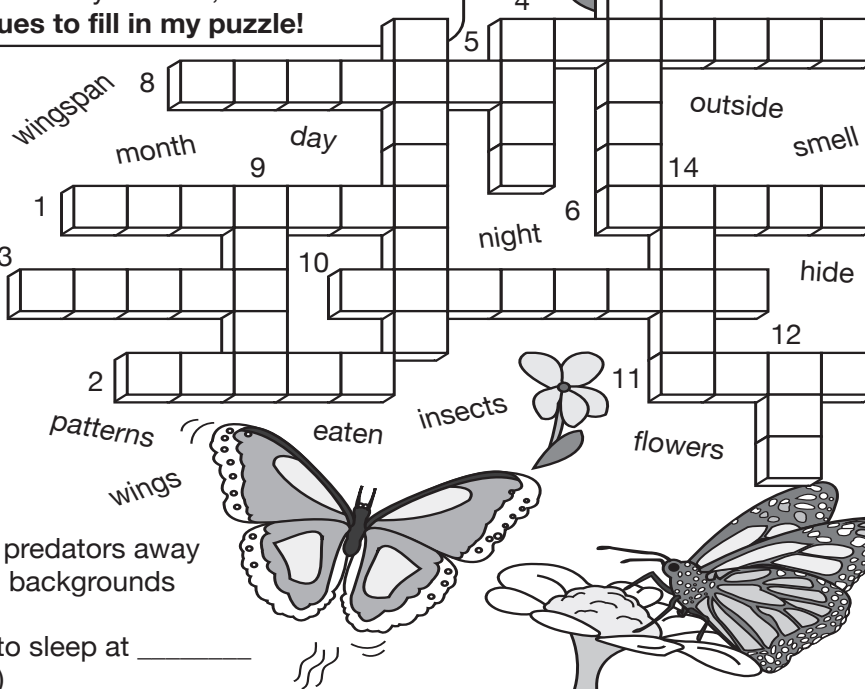


Butterflies

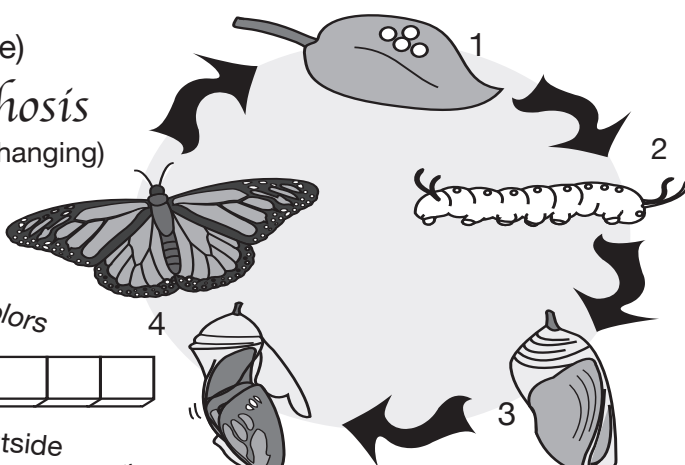
