



A very special welcome to PIP Sid & Lion Judy Scruggs

Sid L. Scruggs III of Vass, North Carolina was elected president of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the Association's 93rd International Convention, held in Sydney, Australia in 2010.

Using his presidential theme, "A Beacon of Hope," Past President Scruggs made service to others—the core principle of Lions clubs around the world—the focal point of his presidency.

A member of the Vass Lions Club, he has held many offices in the Association. In addition, he has presented at the USA/Canada and Europa Leadership forums, and served as an instructor for the Lions Clubs International Leadership Institute and the District Governors-elect School.

In addition to his Lions activies, Past President Scruggs served for many years as chairperson of the board of directors of the North Carolina Governor Morehead School for the Blind. Formerly a pilot, he is also a life member of the American Airlines Grey Eagles Association, and the Naval Academy Alumni Association.

Past President Scruggs was presented with the Order of the Long Leaf Pine, the highest award given by the State of North Carolina, by the Governor of North Carolina. He is a member of the North Carolina Lions Hall of Fame, and in 2010, he was elected to the United States Blind Gold Association Hall of Fame. He has received an honorary doctorate of humanities from World University.

In recognition of his service to the Association, Past President Scruggs has received numerous awards, including the Key of Nations Award for sponsoring more than 100 Lions members, and the Amabassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor the Association gives to its members. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

Past President Scruggs and his wife, Judy, also a Lion and Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow, have four children and 16 grandchildren.







2023 TEXAS LIONS HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES



PDG BILL CRADDOCK is a competent, confident, and contributing leader in Lions Club International. He exemplifies the motto "We Serve" in all areas of his life. As a coach, trainer, and secretary of his local club, Lion Bill has provided guidance for over 30 years as the Canyon Lions Club grew from 50 members to more than 230 members. His leadership does not end with the local club, but extends to District, State and International. His community and church are also beneficiaries of his charismatic sacrificing in the giving of himself.

He served on the Planning and Zoning Commission more than 10 years for the city of Canyon and in most of those years, he served as chairman. He serves as Deacon and Adult Sunday School teacher in his church.

He has been recognized by the Canyon Lions Club as Lion of the Year on two occasions. He was presented a Melvin Jones Award in recognition of his service, along with an International President's Award. Named as Canyon's Citizen of the Year is yet another example of the honors Lion Bill has received. He has also co-chaired the District 2-T1 Cal Farley's Boys Ranch Coat & Shoe project for more than 10 years.

It is fitting that he would be nominated by his club; that the 2-T1 Lions District would select him to represent their membership; and that PDG Bill Craddock would become a member of the prestigious Texas Lions Hall of Fame for 2023.



PCC SCOTT EVANS After joining the Stephenville Lions Club in October 1989, Lion IPCC Scott Evans went to work for the Stephenville Lions Club and the Lions of Texas.

While president of the Stephenville Lions Club (1998-99 and 1999-2000) PCC Scott promoted membership and led by example, sponsoring many new members himself. He brought fun and enthusiasm to the club, pushing all to serve their community and grow the club.

During his time as Vice District Governor and District Governor, Lion Scott traveled to all of the clubs in District 2-E1—a 100% District Governor. PCC Scott is a Progressive Melvin Jones recipient with three diamonds, has a Progressive Jack Wiech Fellow, has received two International President's Award medals, and numerous International President certificates.

PCC Scott served as District Governor of 2-E1 from 1998-99 and again in 2000 to complete the term of our deceased District Governor. PCC Scott served as the Council Chair for Multiple District 2 from 2021-2022, leading the Multiple District to a historic growth in membership.

PCC Scott served the city of Stephenville, Texas on the City Council for 14 years. He has had a long career in the tire industry, and is the owner of Evans Tire Supply.

PCC Scott's family includes his wife, Lion Sherrie and sons Jason, Van, Jay and their families. All of his sons and one daughter-in-law are Lions. It would be almost impossible to list everything he has done for his family, his church, his community, the youth of Texas, and the Lions of Texas.

2023 TEXAS LIONS HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES



DR. NORMAN GOULD embodies the Lion's motto of "We Serve". For 65 years as a Midland Downtown Lion, he has been a true "Knight of the Blind". Dr. Gould served on many committees and in all the VP chairs over the years, and served as Club President in 1986-87. Lion Gould has been awarded a Melvin Jones Fellow, a Ray Gwyn Humanitarian Award, Lion of the Year, a TLERC Silver Vision Award and TLERC's Volunteer of the Year Award. In his honor, TLERC has named their Bronze Fellowship after him. He is a Life Member and has 50+ years of perfect attendance.

Over the decades, Dr. Gould performed hundreds of children's eye exams for the club and TLERC. Before TLERC, when it was just a club project, he was teaching Lions how to read and sort glasses. He is considered one of the two grandfathers of eyeglass recycling, because the training and educational programs he authored became the curriculum for LCIF's Sight First recycling centers. He personally trained

hundreds of Lions, foreign missionaries, church groups and medical teams. Millions of people all over the world can see because of his valuable work.

Norman and his wife, Evelyn were married for almost 60 years. They have three children, five grandchildren, and two great grandchildren. Dr. Gould served in the U.S. Air Force (1954-57) as Optometry Officer at Goodfellow AFB. He and Evelyn went on several VOSH missions to Mexico and Central America to provide eye exams and fitting of glasses. He regularly volunteered at the community theater, the hospital, the Senior Citizens' Center, the Temple Beth El and at Casa de Amigos doing taxes for low-income people. He also served on many boards, including the joint A1/T3 Western Texas Lions Eye Bank Alliance (WTLEBA). Through the Jewish Philanthropic Union, he secured large grants for WTLEBA, TLERC and the Texas Lions Camp.



PDG RONNIE MARTIN was raised in Clute, Texas. He attended Brazosport High School, Brazosport College and the University of Texas.

Ronnie has always felt you should give back to your community, state and country. He spent five years on the Brazoria County Fair board, nine years on the Hospice Care Team board of Brazoria, Matagorda and Galveston counties. He served as a board member of the Brazoria County Military Mom's & Housewives for two yearsM and is currently on a subcommittee for the Main Street board in Freeport. He was selected as "One of The Most Giving People in Lake Jackson, Texas". His business has sponsored a local elementary school for the past five years. He was twice awarded Ambassador of The Year in the Angleton Chamber of Commerce and is currently an Ambassador with the Brazosport Chamber of Commerce.

PDG Ronnie joined Lions in 2006 and serves as President of the Brazosport Breakfast Lions Club. He is a

Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow, a Progressive Jack Wiech Fellow, Ebb Grindstaff Fellow, W. P. Woods Fellow (Indiana Lions), Hellen Keller Fellow (California Lions), was awarded a Lions of Pennsylvania Fellow and a PIP Joseph L. Wroblewski Fellow. He has been awarded numerous other State and District awards, including Lion of the Year in his district. He has been awarded four International President's medals, an International Leadership medal, nine International President's Certificates of Appreciation, attended 11 US/Canadian forums, has been a presenter at three US/Canadian forums and three international conventions, and has attended four international conventions.

He was ranked fifth of all DGs in 2013-2014. He is responsible for the first SPOT camera being used in Texas, and for having Texas law changed so that electronic equipment can be used in public schools for eye screening. It was his motion to name the State Office and Museum after PIP Eb Grindstaff.

2023 TEXAS LIONS HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES



PDG RANDALL MORRIS joined the Dallas Skyline Lions Club in District 2-X1 in 1974. He served as Club President twice, and was also selected Lion of the Year. He served 2-X1 as President of the Executive Council, Region Chair, Zone Chair and State Convention Chair for the first lady Governor of MD-2, PDG Barbara Babcock in 1994-95. He served as District Secretary and later as District Governor in 1998-99. PDG Randall moved to Orange, Texas in 2000 and joined the Orange Lions Club of District 2-S1. He has served the Orange Lions as Club Secretary and Treasurer and was also Lion of the Year in 2009 and 2018. His service to the Orange Club also includes the Carnival Committee, White Cane Committee and delivering food baskets.

PDG Randall has served District 2-S1 as District Secretary from 2002 to the present, as well as Election and Credentials judge. He has served as President of the Lions Eye Bank of Texas, 2018-19 and President of the Lions Foundation for Sight, 2013-15. PDG Randall served the MD-2 Texas Lions Museum and

Foundation as Secretary, and as President of the Past District Governors' Association in 2004-05.

In 47 years as a member of Lions Clubs International, PDG Randall has maintained perfect attendance. He has attended 19 international conventions, 16 USA/Canada Forumsm and 22 MD-2 State conventions.

Lion Randall's awards are numerous. He has been awarded seven International President's Certificates of Appreciation, International President's Leadership medals and one International President's medal in 2007. He is also a Melvin Jones and Jack Weich Fellow.

PDG Randall's service to country and community includes four years in the United States Army, with a year in Korea. He volunteers yearly with the Salvation Army as well as for work days at the Texas Lions Camp.
