I dig to bury bones. I have plenty of food, but I think it's still a way for dogs to keep other dogs from taking their food. Have **vou** ever watched animals to see what they do? - 6. spineless animals, live underground, come out when it rains because it is hard to breathe
- 7. have shells with hinges, burrow into the sand to keep from being eaten
- 8. found in deserts in Africa, 20-30 live in large underground networks
- 9. mammals that tunnel, making bumps in the soil (hills named after them) 10. mammals with long snouts, dig up insects to eat, especially ants
- 11. dig holes for shelter (hole that soldiers dig for protection is named after this)
