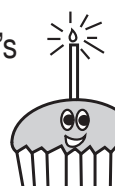
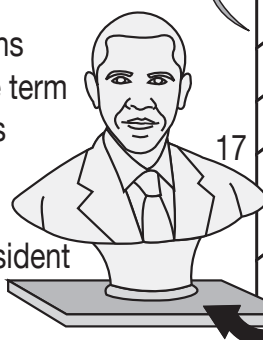
Honoring The Presidents

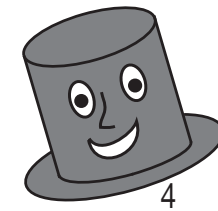
