2024 TEXAS LIONS HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES



PDG GARY LINKER joined Lubbock Lip Lipscomb Lions Club in 1988. This club was always small and mighty but eventually, sadly dissolved. After Lion Gary served in every officer position more than once, he now continues his service in the Lubbock South Plains Lions Club.

As District Governor of 2T2 in 2005-2006, Lion Gary assured stable growth, fund raising, and service. PDG Gary then lent his professional skills of accounting to the Texas Lions Foundation by serving as Trustee and Chairman in 2011-2013.

PDG Gary's unwavering service to Texas Lions Camp solidified his legacy in Texas Lions Leadership. After serving as Elected Director to the Camp, Lion Gary stepped up as 2005-2006 DG's Representative to the Camp's Executive Committee. He devoted many years to TLC and its Board. He became Chairman in 2019-2020. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020, TLC was forced to close its Residence Camp. Working with his Board and CEO Steve Mabry, Chairman Linker created the Family Camp, which continues

today. Parents could bring their special children, reside with them, and experience TLC together. Additionally, Chairman Gary and his team developed the 2017 Camp Master Plan to renovate and revitalize the Camp.

PDG Gary received both the International President's Award and LCI Certificates of Appreciation. He is a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow and a Progressive Texas Lions Foundation Fellow. Lion Gary is a TLC Life Member and Silver Level TLC Century Club Member.

PDG Gary has worked as a CPA for 38 years. In 1994 he graduated from Lubbock Leadership. Gary has devoted 35 years to his church and serves as an Elder. Lion Gary and his partner-in-service, Lion Judy, have been married for 40 years and dote over one son, Justin, a daughter-in-law, Libby, and a grandson, Logan.

PDG Gary Sult said it best about Lion Gary, "I got to see how to put others ahead of myself. I got to see what it looked like to be a servant leader."



PDG GILBERT "GIL" BLANCAS became a Lion in October 2004. He began serving in 2002, selling and delivering Mother's Day roses before he became a Lion. Gil is dedicated to Lionism, community, country, and family.

PDG Gil serves on District 2-T3's Global Extension Team and is Constitution and By-Laws Chairman. He served 2-T3 as Governor, First and Second Vice Governor, and Zone Chair; represented 2-T3 on the Texas Museum and State Office Board for two terms; served as club president twice and chaired several club projects.

In recognition of his service and commitment, Gil has received the International President's Certificate of Appreciation; Melvin Jones, Texas Lions Camp Jack Wiech, Texas Lions Foundation, MD-2 Texas Lions Museum Ebb Grindstaff Fellow Awards; and the World Services for the Blind Order of the Silver Cane Award. He is a Club Legacy Lion.

His current and past volunteer and professional organizations include Alzheimer's Association, AARP, Vietnam Veterans of America, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Sun Bowl Association Basketball Tournament Executive Committee, United Way, American Red Cross, Retired Senior Volunteer Program, Private Industry Council, and Bienvivir Inclusive Senior Health.

A US Navy veteran attaining the rank of Petty Officer Third Class, he honorably served a year in Keyport, Washington; a year in Danang, Vietnam; and two years as staff driver for Rear Admiral E. Grimm, Commander, Training Command, Pacific Fleet.

PDG Gil is retired from University Medical Center El Paso, where he served as Director of Human Resources and Director of Medicare Business Development.

PDG LAWRENCE L. SANCHEZ joined the Killeen Evening Lions Club in 2001 and has faithfully served his Club, District 2-X3, and MD2 since. With 19 years of perfect attendance, Lion Lawrence is always ready to serve.

Lion Lawrence gained knowledge of club operations by holding all leadership positions and numerous committee chairs in his club. He served in many District 2-X3 roles including District Governor in 2013-2014. After his term as Governor, PDG Lawrence went on to hold the offices of President of the 2-X3 PDG Association, LCI New Club consultant where he was instrumental in building 28 Lions Clubs, 2-X3 GLT Coordinator, 2-X3 GMT Coordinator, Texas Lions Museum Trustee, and Texas Lions Museum President. At present, he is serving as his club's Treasurer, the Secretary of the 2-X3 PDG Association, Texas Lions Museum Trustee, and MD2 Global Service Coordinator.

PDG Lawrence has many great achievements in Lionism. He obtained the Membership Key in 2004, Lion of the Year in 2007, and the Club President Excellence Award. In 2005-2006 he organized the First Leo District in Texas. PDG

Lawrence has also been awarded the 2-X3 Tom P. Kirkham Award and the 2-X3 Global Leadership Coordinator Excellence Award. With the Texas Lions Camp, he holds a Jack Wiech Fellowship, a Lifetime Membership, and is a Century Club Member. He is a Texas Lions Fellow and a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow. Lion Lawrence was recognized in 2014 with the District Governor's Team Award and District Governor's Extension Award in 2015. He has received 3 International President's Certificate of Appreciation, 3 International Presidential Medals, and the International Presidential Leadership Medal.

PDG Lawrence retired from the Army after 21 years of service as an Infantry man during the Vietnam and Gulf War Eras. After 17 years with the First Community Services Data Center in Killeen he retired from his position as a computer Operator/Production Control Specialist.

PDG Lawrence has been married to his wife, Lion Sylvia Sanchez, for 51 years and they have 2 sons, Jefferson and Benjamin, and 5 grandchildren.



PDG RODERICK G. "ROD" CHISHOLM, III entered Lionism in 1984 as a member of the San Antonio Founder Lions Club. During his Service. He received numerous awards from his club, District and LCI, including his club's highest recognition, induction into the Founder Lions "Roll of Merit".

Lion "Rod" served as Cabinet Secretary, Vice District Governor, District Governor, and two terms as Chairman of the Lions Sight Research Foundation. He served in many Cabinet positions and was the first President of the Texas Lions Museum. For his leadership, he was named as the District "Lion of the Year" in 1997. committees for the past 40 years, meeting the needs of his community and the world through Lionism.

Lion "Rod" devoted his life to serving the community at large. He is a Past President and Board Member of numerous charitable organizations. For over 20 years, he has become "Santa Claus" for the Elf Louise project. The kids' eyes almost "Pop Out" when they see a 6'6" Santa come bounding into their home.

He has also served in key posts within his Church serving as Parish Council Chairman and Campaign Chairman to build a new Sanctuary.

Lion Chisholm served our country in combat in Vietnam earning the Bronze Star for Valor and the Bronze Star with Oak Leaf Cluster. PDG BETTY L. EZELL began her journey in Lions in 1996 when she joined the Houston Spring Branch Lions Club. Her current membership resides with the Tomball Lions Club, though she maintains an Associate membership with the Houston Lady Lions Club.

Through service in Lions, PDG Betty has held numerous positions. PDG Betty served as club president, secretary, director, and membership chair. Before serving as District Governor in 2017-2018, PDG Betty served as Zone and Region Chair inspiring clubs to find new ways to serve their communities.

PDG Betty served two terms as Cabinet Secretary. PDG Betty served as the District convention committee chair, capping several years of service on the committee. PDG Betty served on the Camper Transportation Committee for over 17 years helping to coordinate buses and campers.

Among her highest achievements was serving as an Elected Director to the Texas Lions Camp. Currently, PDG Betty serves as a Guiding Lion for the Magnolia Tri-County Lions Club.

At the start of her year as District Governor, Hurricane Harvey struck the Texas Gulf Coast. The four coastal Lions Districts suffered tremendous damage. Finally, Scott worked with TLC leadership to develop a training program for Elected Directors and has provided valuable insight during the VIP weekend for six years to better promote TLC.

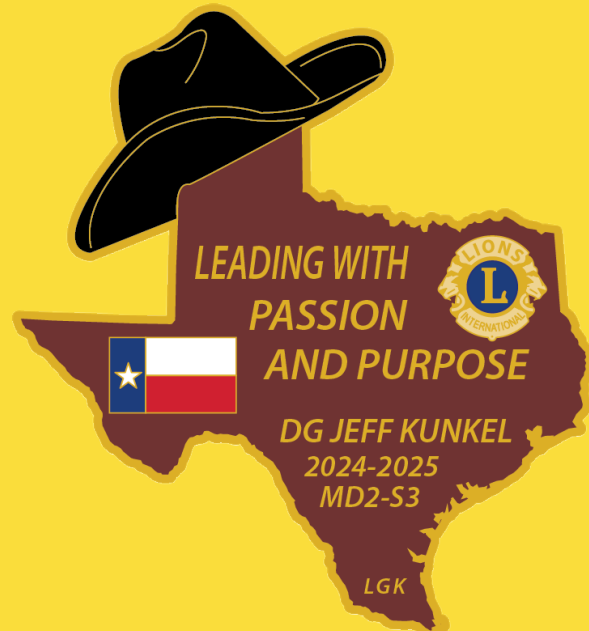

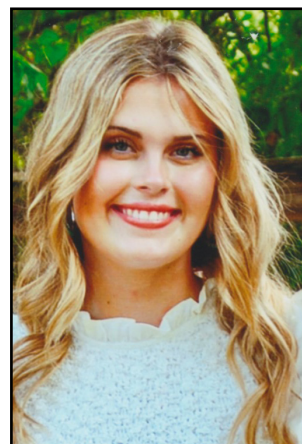
