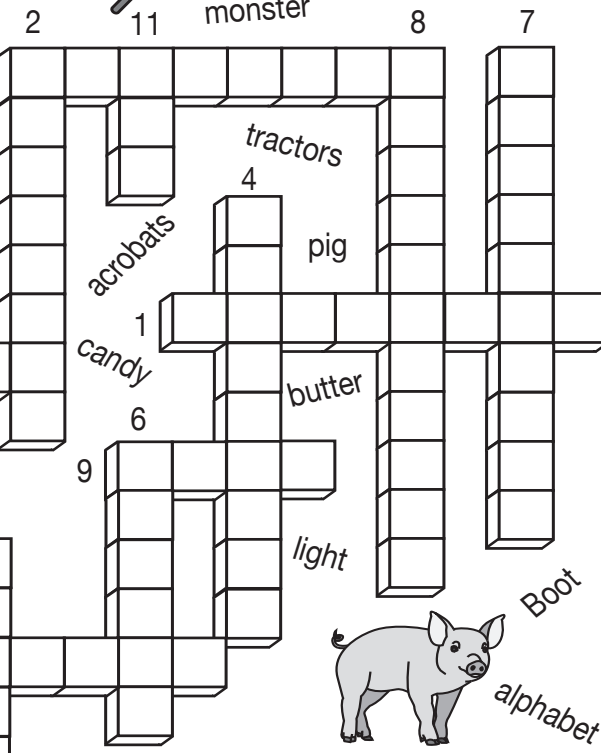
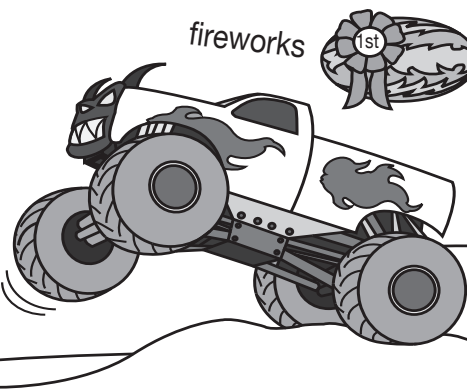
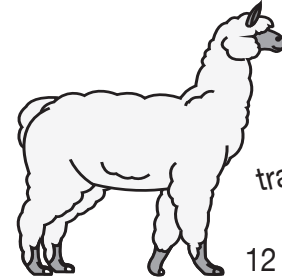
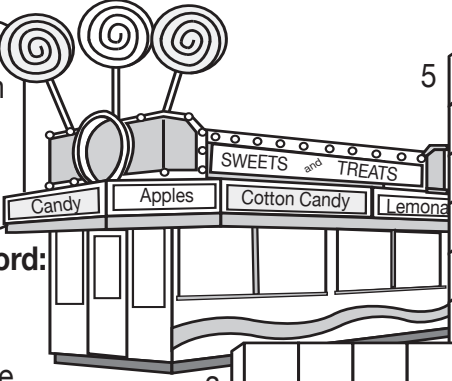


**Let's Go to the Fair!**
