The Year of the Snake

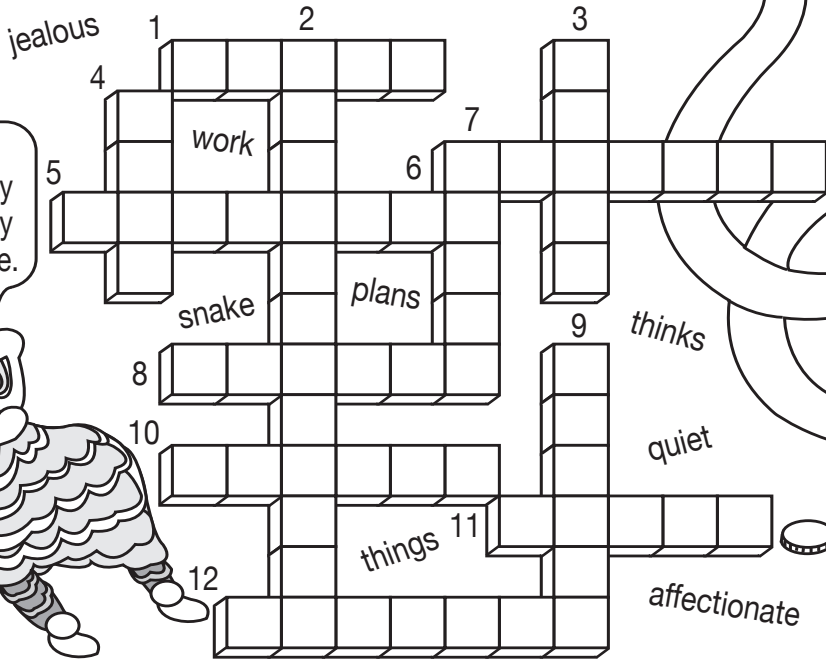
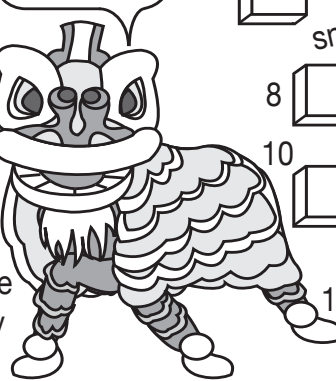
