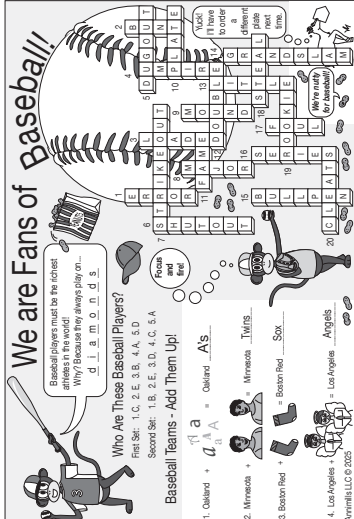
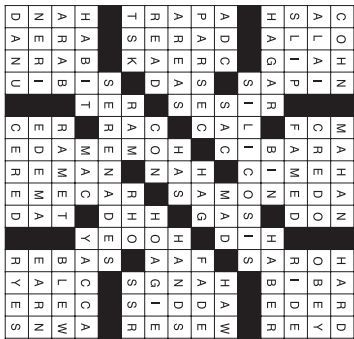

APPLICATION. City of Hedley, P.O. Box 185, Hedley, Texas 79237, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to renew Texas Land Application Permit (TLAP) No. WQ0010709001 to authorize the disposal of treated wastewater at a volume not to exceed a daily average flow of 50,000 gallons per day via surface irrigation of 20 acres of nonpublic access grassland. The domestic wastewater treatment facility and disposal area are located northeast of the City of Hedley, approximately 1.2 miles north and 0.8 mile east of the intersection of U.S. Highway 287 and State Highway 203, near the city of Hedley, in Donley County, Texas 79237. TCEQ received this application on April 14, 2025. The permit application will be available for viewing and copying at Hedley City Hall, 109 Main Street, Hedley, in Donley County, Texas, prior to the date this notice is published in the newspaper.

A public meeting is not a contested case hearing. **OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING.** After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. IN YOUR REQUEST: your name, address, phone number; applicant's name and proposed permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the proposed facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; a list of all disputed issues of fact that you submit during the comment period and, the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law relating to relevant and material water quality concerns submitted during the comment period.

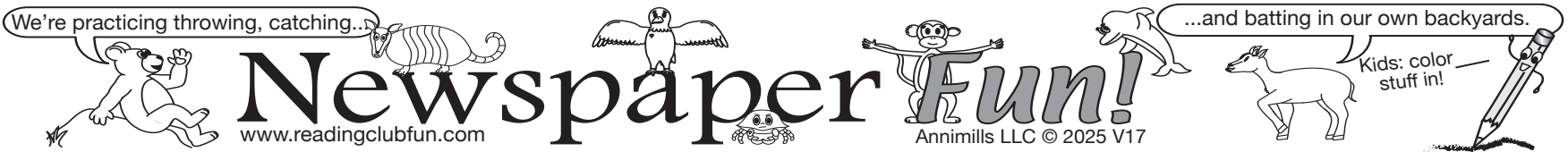
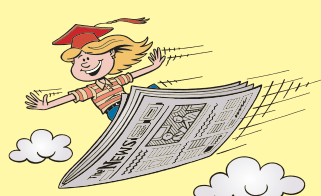
