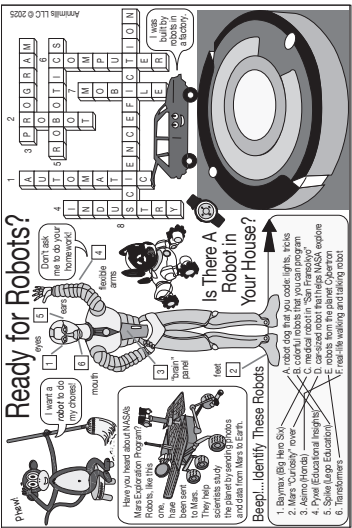
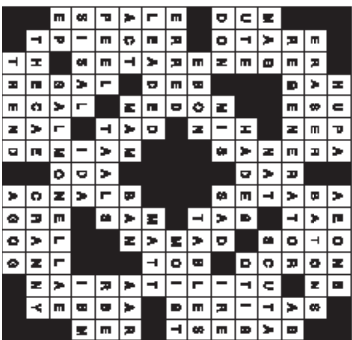

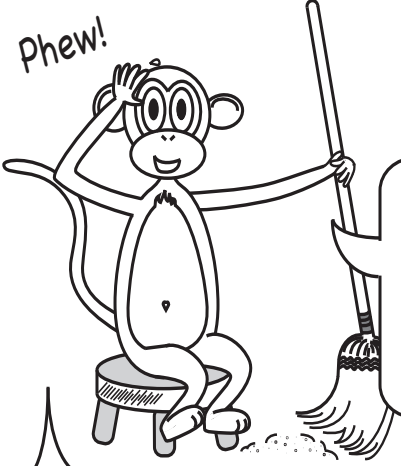

The kind of robot I really want is only found in science fiction stories and movies. Most robots that exist today are used in industry to make cars or other items. Some are used to paint or pack items.

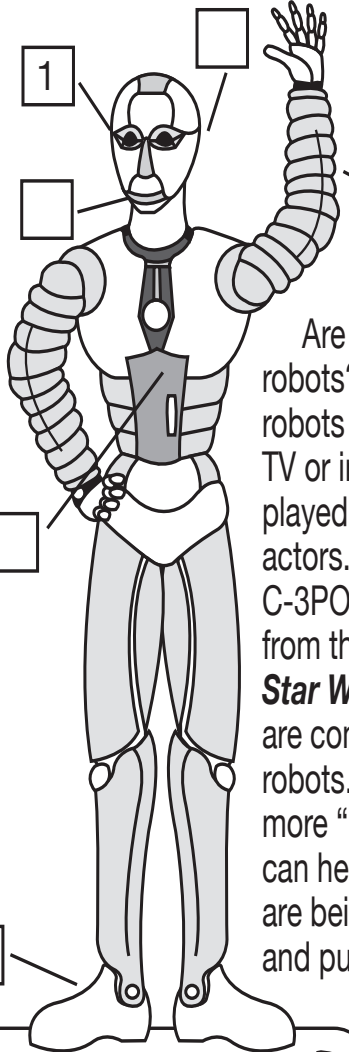
Robots in movies often look like humans, while real-life factory robots usually have only one big arm to do the work they are built to do.

Check out my robot! Can you fill in the number where he has:

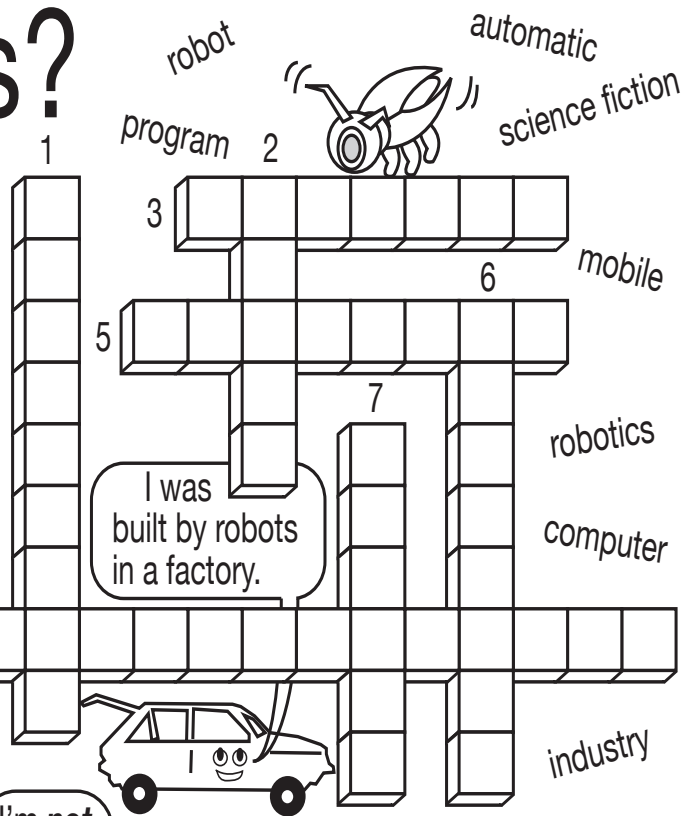
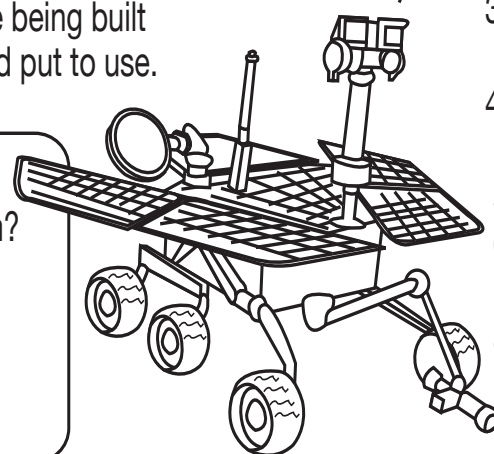
1. cameras for eyes
